

Father Philip Doyle, Priest for 70 Years

Father Philip R. Doyle, a priest in the archdiocese for 70 years, died June 30 at Putnam Hospital Center in Carmel. He was 95.

Cardinal Dolan will offer the Funeral Mass at noon on Saturday, July 7, at St. James the Apostle in Carmel. Msgr. Joseph Martin will deliver the homily.

Father Doyle was temporary administrator of St. Veronica, Manhattan, 1976-1983. He went on sick leave in 1983 and retired in 1992.

He was parochial vicar of St. Mary Star of the Sea, the Bronx, 1961-1976;

St. John the Evangelist, Mahopac, 1960-1961; St. Paul, Congers, 1955-1960; Corpus Christi, Manhattan, 1954-1955; Holy Family, the Bronx, 1949-1954; and St. Patrick, Yorktown Heights, 1948-1949.

Born in Manhattan, Father Doyle attended Fordham University and St. Joseph's Seminary, Dunwoodie. He was ordained in 1948 by Cardinal Francis Spellman.

Burial follows the Funeral Mass in Holy Sepulcher Cemetery, New Rochelle.

Deacon Canals, Served Bronx Parishes

Deacon Dhoel Canals, who served at Holy Family, Blessed Sacrament and St. John Vianney parish in the Bronx for 29 years, died May 26 at his Bronx residence. He was 81.

Deacon Canals was at Holy Family, Blessed Sacrament and St. John Vianney, 1989-2018, and served at St. John Chrysostom, the Bronx, 1977-1989. His ministries included tending to the liturgical and spiritual needs of the parish and coordinating the lectors, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion and

altar servers.

Born in Manhattan, Deacon Canals was a photographer who graduated from James Monroe High School, the Bronx, and attended the Germain School of Photography, Manhattan. He was ordained by Cardinal Terence Cooke in 1977.

His wife, Edith, and son, Dhoel Mark, survive him.

A Funeral Mass was offered May 31 at Holy Family Church, the Bronx. Burial was in St. Raymond Cemetery, the Bronx.

Deacon Longo, Served Two Parishes

Deacon Ralph Longo, who served at Annunciation parish in Crestwood for the past 12 years, died June 11 at Westchester Medical Center in Valhalla after a long battle with cancer. He was 84.

Deacon Longo served at Annunciation, 2006-2018. He was assigned to Holy Rosary, Greenwood Lake, 1975-2006. His ministries included working with Catholic Charities, the parish choir, the altar servers and religious education.

Born in the Bronx, Deacon Longo

was ordained by Cardinal Terence Cooke in 1975.

He earned a bachelor's degree from Fordham University and was a special education teacher for 37 years.

His son, Patrick, daughter-in-law, Jeanine, and grandchildren, Nicole, Jon and Jeanine, survive him. His wife of 46 years, Jane, and an infant son, Ralph, predeceased him.

A Funeral Mass was offered June 15 at Annunciation Church. Burial followed in St. Stephen Cemetery, Warwick.
