FAMILIES MAKE NEWS

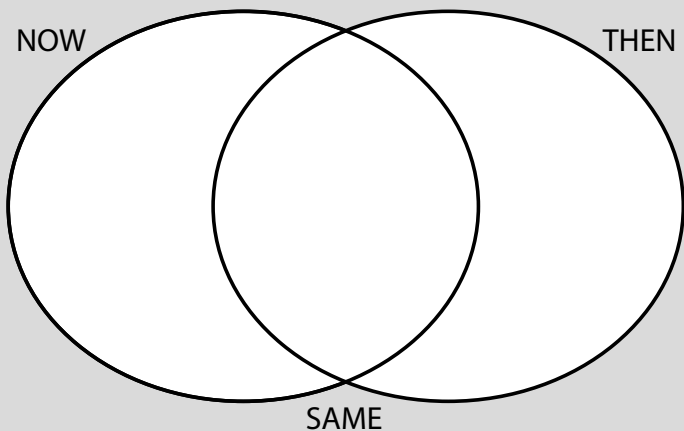
Reporters write many stories. Today's reporter is working on a story about family life.
