PCHC announces another death

The Polk County Health Center announced an additional COVID-19 related death in the county this week. According to a post on social media, the person was over the age of 85 and “was fully vaccinated.” “PCHC would like to ex-

tend our condolences to the family and friends of a Polk County resident who recently passed due to COVID-19,” the post stated. The new death brings the county’s total death toll for the entire pandemic to at least 52. The Polk County Health Center reported 4,752 total cases as of press time Friday, with the county’s total active

cases at 88. Currently, 235 Polk County residents are quarantined. On Friday, Citizens Memorial Hospital in Bolivar reported 10 COVID-19 inpatients. Polk County’s vaccination rate remains at 32.2% for those fully vaccinated, according to the state’s COVID-19 dashboard on Friday. The dashboard reports 37.3% have

initiated vaccination. Statewide, 44.6% of Missourians are fully vaccinated as of Friday, per the dashboard. Those rates are in contrast to the 51.9% of Americans reported as fully vaccinated by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control as of Friday.

‘We can do this’

Bolivar R-1 discusses sub shortage and tax levy

As the Bolivar R-1 School District is through its first week of the new school year, all the work the staff and employees did over the summer to prepare for incoming students is finally being used. At the Thursday, Aug. 19, school board meeting, school board members and guests alike recognized various impactful people for their work. From Russ Martin and his bus inspections, to Kathy Drake and the Back to School Extravaganza committee and sponsors and to principals like Andy Love and Brooke Campbell, names of those who worked hard for the school this summer were recognized.

However, at the meeting, one challenge superintendent Richard Asbill said the district will face this year is the lack of substitutes. There is a lack of substitute teachers, custodians, cooks and bus drivers, Asbill said. The state approved modifying substitute teachers’ requirements, with the intent of making more subs available, he added.

Assistant superintendent T.C. Wall said the district is implementing Bearcats Teach, where Southwest Baptist University students partner with schools to help provide substitute alternatives.

There are currently two students from the program at the primary school and one at the high school, she said. Usually, the board said there are 60 to 65 substitute teachers, but currently See R-1, Page 3A

Here to stay

Sitting in the heart of Bolivar is a post office that has been bringing packages to the community’s homes and businesses for decades. And according to Scott Anderson, the current postmaster in charge, it’s not going anywhere anytime soon, despite appearances. Anderson confirmed the building was to be sold at an auction — with its existing United States Postal Service lease, which still has more than a year left, remaining in place. On Thursday, Aug. 26, the USPS office building and its half-acre lot — located at 328 S. Main Ave. — was one of 10 properties on the bidding block at a Diamond S Auction and Real Estate’s multi-property auction. The results of the auction were not available as of press time. According to previous coverage, the Bolivar Post Office has been in its present facility since the 1960s. In 2008, the BH-FP reported plans were in place to eventually build a new post office. However, those plans have not materialized in the more than 13 See Post, Page 3A

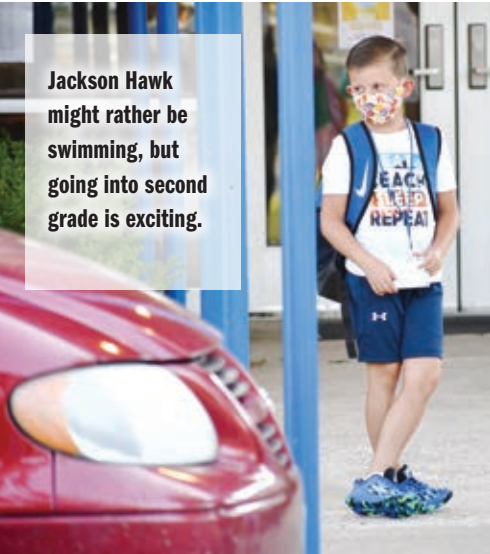

years since the original announcement.

In 2014, previous coverage noted the board of aldermen approved a resolution to be sent to the U.S. Postal Service asking for a larger facility to be built in Bolivar and also suggesting broader boundaries for the location search for the new facility.

Anderson declined to share more details, saying he personally wasn't allowed to talk with the press about the property.

A USPS spokesperson did not respond to a request for more information by press time Friday.

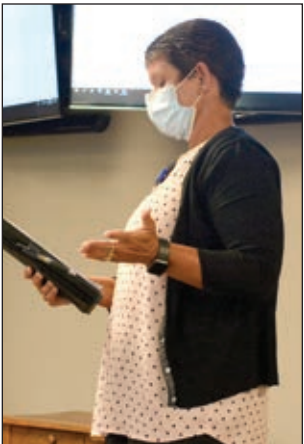
there are only around 25.

"We're very short staffed," Asbill said, adding that Bolivar Schools has one food service substitute — for the entire district.

He said if the school approves a teacher's personal day, and there are no subs available, the school may have to provide subs in the form of the principals or other staff.

Emily Solem Clasby

On Aug. 20, 2021, the strong, lively spirit of Emily Solem Clasby passed from this life. So many remember her for the fun and laughter she created wherever she went. She was the keeper of family lore and photos, and because of her we learned about Norwegian ancestors, the family home place near Duluth, the great northern Minnesota forest fire when she was an infant, and what it was like to cook for, do chores with, and celebrate holidays with 16 siblings.

She would laugh as she offered this farewell, "You be good now, and I'll work on it!"

Emily was a scrapper and saver, an early recycler of cans, bottles and foil, and she was a collector of spoons and menus. She was proud of the medals she won when she participated in the Senior Olympics, and she was active all her life, even after a battle with cancer and after macular degeneration had robbed her of her sight. Every day, she would grab her walker and count off laps around the deck outside the house.

to Mary and Adolph Solem. Her mother passed away when she was only 3 months old, but her father remarried and her loving stepmother, Gladys, helped raise her.
