

## Guy Molinari, Served in Congress And as Staten Island Borough President

Guy V. Molinari, a former member of Congress and Staten Island borough president, died July 25 after a lengthy illness. He was 89.

A graduate of Wagner College and New York Law School, Molinari was an attorney before and after his political career. He served as a New York state assemblyman, 1975-1980; congressman, 1981-1989, and Staten Island borough president, 1990-2001.

A Funeral Mass was offered July 28 at Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, Staten Island, with Auxiliary Bishop John O'Hara as celebrant.

Molinari was outspoken in his support for pro-life positions and advocates, even when that position was unpopular.

As borough president, Molinari led the fight to close Fresh Kills landfill in 2001. It is being transformed into 2,200-acre Freshkills Park scheduled to open in the 2030s.

"He loved Staten Island, he loved his country, and he loved his family. He was never afraid to stand up and be heard,"

said Msgr. Peter Finn, dean of Staten Island and pastor of Blessed Sacrament on Staten Island, who led a prayer service at Molinari's wake.

Following his political career, Molinari represented first responders and others who had their health impacted by the attack on the World Trade Center in 2001.

"He was a very active borough president and was so determined," Msgr. Finn said. "He was a tough guy, a good guy and willing to help if he could."

Born in Manhattan, Molinari served as a U.S. Marine during the Korean War.

His daughter Susan Molinari and her husband, Bill Paxon, both of whom represented New York in the U.S. House of Representatives, and granddaughters Susan Ruby and Katherine Mary Paxon survive him. He is also survived by three sisters.

His wife, Marguerite, predeceased him in 2008.

Burial was in Moravian Cemetery, Staten Island.

## Father Scully, Pastor in Narrowsburg

Father William Scully, O.F.M., who was pastor of St. Francis Xavier parish in Narrowsburg for nine years, died July 15 in Pompton Plains, N.J. He was 78.

Father Scully served at St. Francis Xavier from 2005 until his retirement in 2014 to Holy Name Friary in Ringwood, N.J.

He was a policy analyst of Asian Pacific affairs at the Heritage Foundation and was a special assistant to late Sen. William Roth of Delaware.

Born in the Bronx, he entered the Franciscan Friars of the Holy Name Province

in 1961 and professed final vows in 1966. He was ordained to the priesthood at the Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land in Washington, D.C., in 1967.

He earned a bachelor's degree from Fairfield University in Connecticut, a master's from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., and a doctorate from New York University.

A Funeral Mass was offered July 19 at St. Anthony of Padua Church in Butler, N.J. Burial was in Mount Calvary Cemetery, Butler.

## Sister Mary Frances, Served 36 Years in Zimbabwe

Sister Mary Frances Kobets, M.M., who served 36 years as a missionary to Zimbabwe, died June 29 in Gweru, Zimbabwe. She was 76.

Sister Fran taught agriculture at the Teachers' College in Zimbabwe, and she became the head of its agriculture department and supervisor in the farm and production unit, 1982-1989. In 2001, she founded the organization Orphans Education and Agriculture Support, which helps HIV/AIDS orphans and

children at risk in the African nation.

Her first overseas assignment was in Makoko, Tanzania.

Born in Kansas City, Mo., she entered the Maryknoll Sisters in 1959 and professed final vows in 1968.

A Funeral Mass was offered July 2 at the Driefontein Mission in Gweru, where burial followed. A Memorial Mass was held July 21 in Annunciation Chapel at the Maryknoll Sisters Center in Ossining.
