Retired Paterson Bishop Frank Rodimer, 91

etired Bishop Frank J. Rodimer of Paterson, N.J., died Dec. 6 at St. Joseph's Home for the Elderly in Totowa, N.J. He was 91.

When Bishop Rodimer became the sixth bishop of the diocese Feb. 28, 1978, he had the unique distinction of being installed as the only priest of the

Paterson Diocese to have been raised to the episcopacy. He retired in 2004.

His Funeral Mass was celebrated Dec. 15 at St. John the Baptist Cathedral in Paterson.

His ministry in the Paterson Diocese began May 19, 1951, when he was ordained to the priesthood.

Sister Ann, Principal in Pearl River, Bronx

Sister Ann Connolly, O.P., who was principal of St. Margaret's School in Pearl River for 20 years, died Nov. 12 in Montifiore Hospital in the Bronx. She was 84.

Sister Ann was principal at St. Margaret's, 1972-1992. She also served as principal of St. Luke School, the Bronx, 1968-1972, where she was a teacher, 1955-1962. She taught at Cardinal Hayes High School, the Bronx, 1993-2002, and St. Dominic School, Blauvelt, 1954-1955.


Sister Ann served at St. Raymond Academy for Girls, the Bronx, from **n Pearl River, Bronx** 2003 until her retirement in 2011. She then volunteered at St. Luke School and

Siena House, the Bronx, until her death. Born in the Bronx, she entered the

Dominican Sisters of Blauvelt in 1951 and professed final vows in 1956.

She earned a bachelor's degree in education from Dominican College, Blauvelt, and a master's in education from Fordham University.

Her brothers, James and Patrick, survive her. A Funeral Mass was offered Nov. 20 in St. Dominic's Convent, Blauvelt. Burial was in St. Dominic's Convent Cemetery.



He was secretary for Paterson Bishop James Navagh and attended the Second Vatican Council with him in 1963. He was appointed diocesan chancellor in 1964. In 1966, he was appointed secretary of the diocesan board of consultors.

As bishop, he led the diocese for 26 years until his retirement in May 2004. He established 12 parishes, and ordained 91 priests and 179 permanent deacons.

In 1999, he supported a bill introduced in the state Legislature to abolish capital punishment in New Jersey. "Precisely because we love and cherish the gift of life, we are challenged to oppose the death penalty," Bishop Rodimer said.



Bishop Frank Rodimer


His 1992 pastoral letter, "Put Our Children First," listed a comprehensive plan Catholics can undertake on behalf of children.

Born in Rockaway, N.J., he attended Seton Hall Prep School in South Orange and

St. Charles College in Catonsville, Md., which was a minor seminary.

He went St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore, Immaculate Conception Seminary in New Jersey and The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., where he earned a licentiate in sacred theology. He returned to the university after his ordination for graduate studies. He also earned a doctorate in canon law.

Bishop Rodimer was a member of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy. He served on the bishops' Administrative Committee and he was chairman of the Committee for the American College at Louvain, Belgium. —*CNS*
