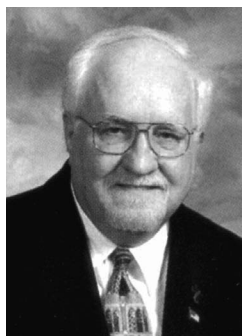


## Deacon diTargiani, Served Scarsdale Parish for 27 Years

Deacon Robert diTargiani, who served at Immaculate Heart of Mary parish in Scarsdale for 27 years, died Aug. 13 after a prolonged illness. He was 81.

Deacon diTargiani served at Immaculate Heart of Mary since 1992. A vital part of the liturgical and spiritual life of the parish, he officiated at wake services and baptisms, visited the homebound and ministered to the sick at White Plains Hospital. On a weekly basis, he officiated committal services at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Hawthorne.

Born in Manhattan, he attended Cardinal Hayes High School, the Bronx, and was ordained to the permanent diaconate by Cardinal John O'Connor at St. Patrick's Cathedral in 1992.

His wife, Natalie, and sons, Robert and Joseph, survive him.

## Sister Vincent, Teacher, Principal

Sister Vincent Cirelli, O.P., who served as a teacher, principal and religious education director at schools and parishes in the archdiocese, died Aug. 21 in the St. Martin de Porres Community at the motherhouse of the Sisters of St. Dominic in Blauvelt. She was 91.

Sister Vincent was principal of Holy Spirit School, the Bronx, 1977-1981. She was director of religious education at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton parish, Shrub Oak, 1972-1974, and regional director of religious education for Dutchess and Putnam Counties, 1969-1972.

She taught at St. Joseph School, Millbrook, 1961-1972; Our Lady of Victory, the Bronx, 1959-1961; St. Margare

ret, Pearl River; 1954-1959; and St. Anselm, the Bronx, 1953-1954.

She also served in religious education in New Jersey and as a pastoral assistant in Albany.

Born in Providence, R.I., she entered the Dominican Sisters of Blauvelt in 1951 and made final vows in 1955. She held a bachelor's degree in education from Dominican College in Orangeburg, and a master's in theology from LaSalle University in Philadelphia.

She is survived by her sister, Flora Papa. Her twin sister, Sister Mary Cirelli, O.P., predeceased her.

A Funeral Mass was offered Aug. 26 at St. Dominic Convent in Blauvelt. Burial was at St. Dominic Cemetery.

## Brother Greenan, Served at Iona Prep

Brother John Greenan, C.F.C., who served at Iona Prep for two years, died Aug. 19 at Montefiore Hospital in New Rochelle. He was 79.

Brother Greenan was assigned to Iona Prep, 2016-2019. He also served in California, Washington, Hawaii, Illinois, Canada, Ireland and Italy.

Born in Manhattan, he attended Rice High School in Harlem and St. Joseph's Juniorate in West Park. He

entered the Congregation of Christian Brothers in 1955 and professed final vows in 1965.
