

Sister Mary Judith Henchey, Principal

Sister Mary Judith Henchey, R.D.C., who served as principal of St. John the Evangelist School in Mahopac for 34 years, died Dec. 12. She was 87.

Sister Mary Judith was principal at St. John the Evangelist, 1967-2001. She previously taught at St. John the Evangelist and St. Joseph School, Croton Falls.

After retiring as principal, she volunteered in the food pantry at St. John the Evangelist.

Born in Woburn, Mass, she entered

the Sisters of the Divine Compassion in 1953 and professed final vows in 1961.

She earned a bachelor's degree in English from Good Counsel College, White Plains, and a master's in school administration from Fairfield University, Fairfield, Conn.

Her brother, Father Joseph Henchey, C.S.S., survives her.

A Funeral Mass was offered Dec. 19 in Chapel of the Divine Compassion, White Plains. Burial was in Mount Calvary Cemetery, White Plains.

Sister Margaret Mary Chiffriller, Educator

Sister Margaret Chiffriller, C.S.J.B., who served as provincial superior of the Sisters of St. John the Baptist from the 1970s to 1990s, died Dec. 7 at Providence Rest Nursing Home in the Bronx. She was 88.

Sister Margaret Mary served intermittently as provincial superior for Sisters of St. John the Baptist from the early 1970s into the 1990s. She was vicar of the congregation's American Province, 1969-1972.

She served as an elementary and high school teacher at St. John Villa Academy on Staten Island, 1951-1962. She later was principal and taught at

a school in Gloversville.

In the Bronx, she served as superior of Providence Rest Convent, 1999-2002, and St. Dominic Convent, 1993-1999.

In later years, she was director of Providence Rest child day care, and led the home's spiritual care department.

Born in Manhattan, she entered the Sisters of St. John the Baptist in 1946 and made final vows in 1956.

She is survived by nieces, nephews and cousins.

A Funeral Mass was offered Dec. 12 at Providence Rest Convent Chapel. Burial was at Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Hawthorne.

October

■ The final document of the Oct. 6-27 Synod of Bishops for the Amazon looked at ways the Church can increase its ministry in the region. But at the heart of the document was the need to bring the Good news to the Amazon, a mission that includes safeguarding the indigenous peoples, cultures and land that are under constant threat of annihilation.

November

■ The Trump administration Nov. 1 announced a proposed rule to allow faith-based adoption and foster care agencies to follow their deeply held religious beliefs and not place children with same-sex couples.

■ On the second day of their Nov. 11-13 fall assembly in Baltimore, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops elected Archbishop Jose H. Gomez of Los An-

geles to a three-year term as president of the USCCB—he is the first Latino to be elected USCCB president—and Archbishop Allen H. Vigneron of Detroit as conference vice president.

December

■ As part of the celebrations for his 50th anniversary of priesthood, Dec. 13, Pope Francis chose to personally present a multi-volume collection of writings by his longtime spiritual director, the late Jesuit Father Miguel Angel Fiorito.

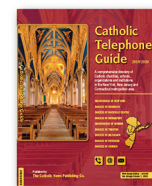
