#### **Did You Know?**

- Current Library Building: Built in1954 for \$50,000. The Total Construction Cost (all three wings) was \$406,202.
- The library has had five different locations throughout the years, with the new Mount Vernon Library Commons being the sixth!
- Physical Items in the Collection Today: 73,844
- Items to move: 59,075
- Digital Items: Access to over 1 million items
- Annual Circulation: 275,000-plus items
- Oldest Item: Printed July 1908
- Newest Item: Printed Last Week
- When the library collection is moved to its new home this month, it will be done by a team of almost 40 movers, library staff and volunteers and is anticipated to take two days. The books will be loaded onto book carts and into trucks for their short trip down the street and then placed and organized by staff onto the new library stacks shelving.
