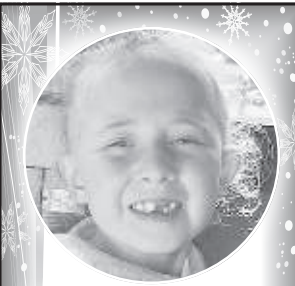

**What do you wish you could see, hear, read or**

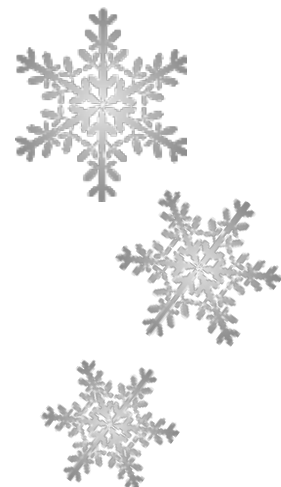
**experience for the first time all over again?**

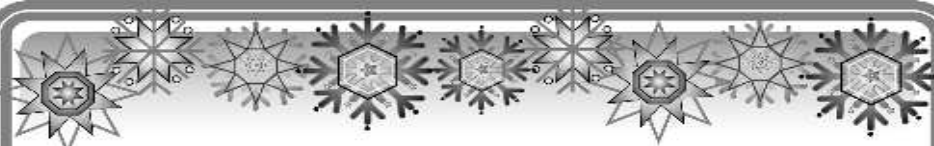
