S.D. State Fair — Where Friends and Family meet

The 2021 South Dakota State Fair is about to open its doors and, according to Assistant State Fair Manager Candi Briley, all signs point toward a full and perhaps record setting event, highlighted by turning ground on a new building and a strong entertainment lineup.

"We're in the home stretch in preparing for this year's fair," Briley said recently from her office in the state fair offices. "We have a plan, but last minute things always come up and for us, having a list of priorities helps us be as prepared as we can be."

Briley said that as fair time nears, ticket sales for the wide array of events scheduled at the grandstand are strong and that spaces on the state fair's campgrounds are filling up with reservations.

When last year's fair took place,



grandstand entertainment was limited by the effects of COVID-19. While the pandemic still lurks, the fair will again feature the hand sanitizing and washing stations throughout the grounds.

"And just as we did last year, we are encouraging anyone who isn't feeling well to avoid contact with others," Briley added. No mask requirements are in place for this year's fair, but mask use is up to each individual.

The Lineup

"I am very excited about the entertainment for this year's fair," Briley said. "We have something for everyone, really, scheduled at the



grandstand this year." Tickets for all of the grandstand entertainment can be purchased through the state fair's website – sdstatefair.com – and Briley reminds those interested in grandstand shows that their concert ticket also gets them onto the fairgrounds that day with no entry fee, only if bought on or before Wednesday, Sept. 1.

Grandstand entertainment will begin before the fair does, as Red Wilk Construction and world champion Tuff Hedeman team up for the 2021 Bull Bash, on Wednesday, Sept. 1 and Thursday, Sept. 2, at 8 p.m. both nights.

On Friday night, rock legend Bret

Michaels will take the stage. The former front man for the hair band "Poison" will rock the band's songbook and will team with Warrant on a 7 p.m. show that will rattle the grandstand.

Saturday night's coveted showcase event for 2021 is country music up and comer Dustin Lynch, along with Ross Ellis. Both young men are rising stars in the business and will be a popular concert this year, Briley said.

The focus remains on country music for the Sunday night show, featuring Jon Pardi and Larry Fleet. This show will again feature two artists who are making their way up the

country charts as they build their music career.

The final grandstand entertainment, set for 1 p.m. on Monday, Sept. 6, is the ATV Big Air Tour. The tour was part of the state fair entertainment package last year and are back due to the fan base they built.

"The ATV Big Air Tour will be back and this year it is going to be free to attend," Briley said. "Anyone on the fairgrounds will be able to come watch these high flyers at no additional charge."

Briley encourages those interested to get tickets early through the website or by calling the state fair office. The state fair app for smartphones is also a good way to have the fair schedule, map, list of both commercial and food vendors (and their location on the fairgrounds) and much more in the palm of your hand.

Briley noted that reports of other fair and similar events thus far have seen large and even record-breaking turnouts, as people emerge from COVID restrictions and seek to get

back and see friends. "Without a doubt, the most exciting event this year may be the groundbreaking on Thursday, Sept. 2, for the new Dakota Events CompleX (DEX)," Briley said. "Losing the Beef Complex to fire last year was wrenching, but to see what has grown out of that tragedy is truly wonderful."

Ticket prices for the fair are still \$6 for adults and \$4 for kids and gains you entrance to a wide range of entertainment possibilities. "We continue to try to keep the entertainment on the Freedom Stage new and fresh and this year is no different," Briley said. "We have renovated our beer garden and will have a ribbon-cutting there on the same day as the DEX groundbreaking."

Additions to the Taphouse, featuring S.D. beers, and the Wine Pavilion will keep things fresh and new and a list of new food vendors will give a wide range of cuisine choices for this year's fair. "We're down to the final details and I think this year's fair will be one to remember," Briley said.

Wild World of Animals

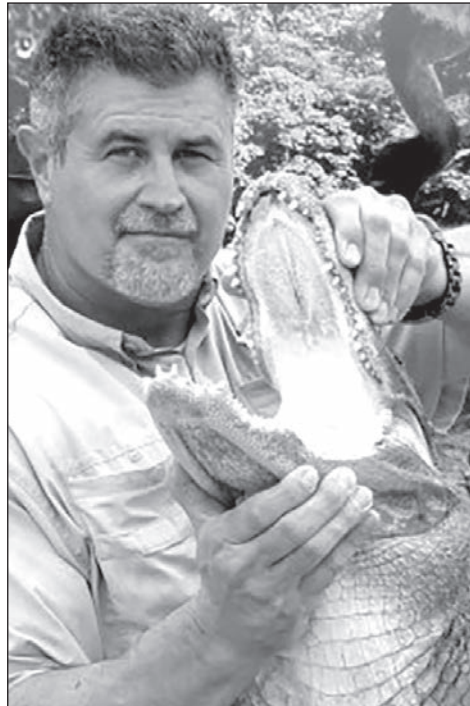
The Wild World of Animals show is one of the premier grounds acts in the entertainment industry.

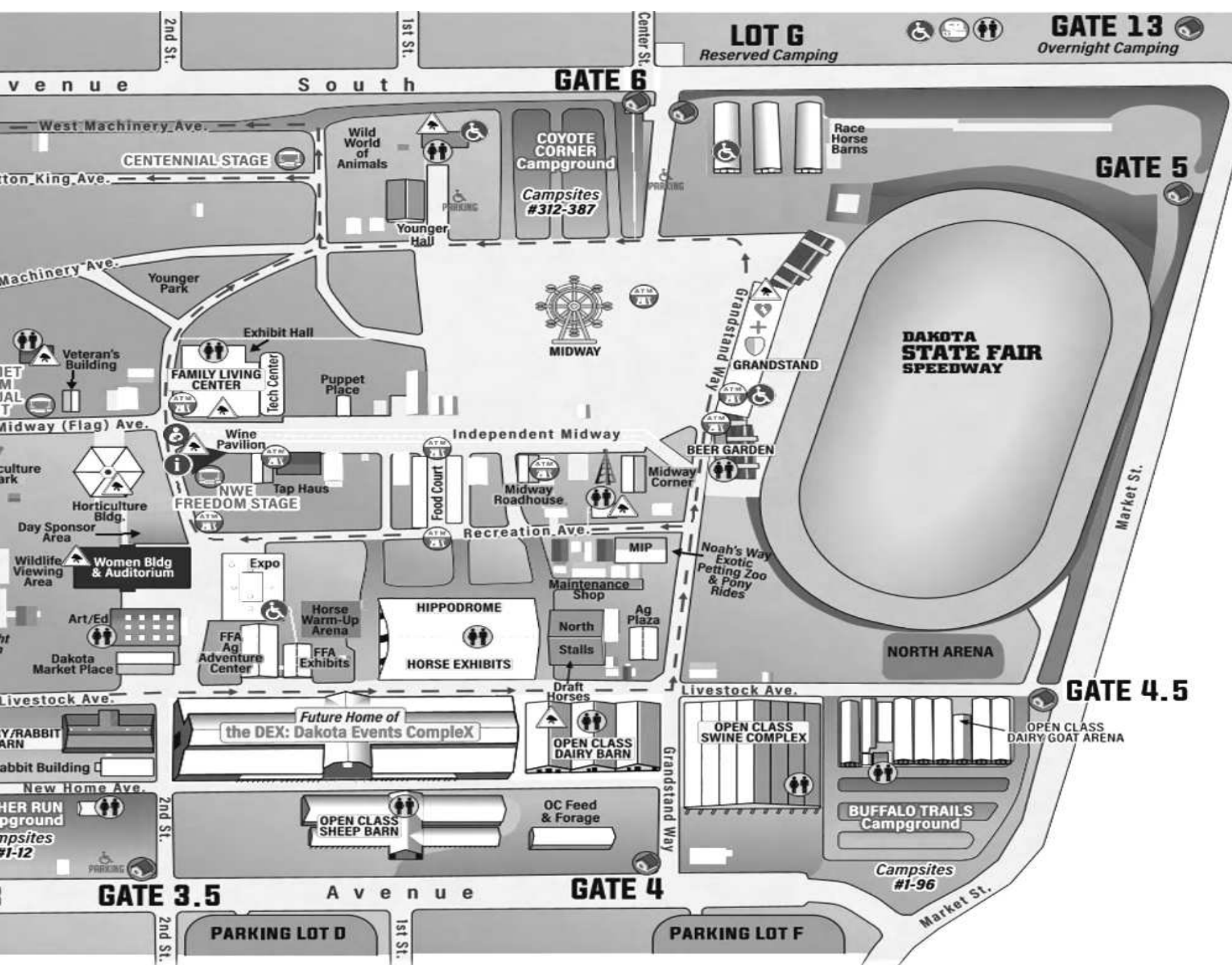



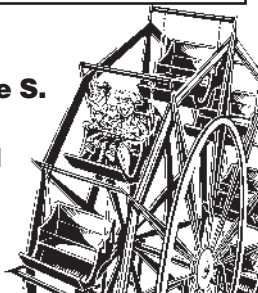

The Red Wilk Construction American Hero Award will be held during both nights of bull riding. Typically, eight Veterans are honored each night, and since 2013, more than 100 Veterans from all over South Dakota have been honored.

This action-packed event marks the annual kick-off of the South Dakota State Fair, featuring two nights of high energy, family friendly fun!

Hedeman formed the Tuff Hedeman Bull Riding Tour after serving for 23 years as the former head of the two nationally organized professional bull riding organizations (PBR and CBR). Hedeman retired from the sport in 1999.

Since 2005, the late August stop on the Tuff Hedeman Bull Riding Tour has launched and funded many professional bull riding careers. Huron, South Dakota, has been the site of grand comebacks, tragic and heartbreaking career endings, and in some years it has set the pace for the next season, positioning the bull rider to win a World title.

In front of a boisterous standing room only crowd, year after year the azure blue colored sky seems to stand still for a breathtaking sunset as Tuff Hedeman and the boys enter through the center gate.

There is no doubt that with 14 years of pro bull riding on the record in Huron, hundreds of thousands of dollars in cash has been awarded. Somewhere in the neighborhood of 1,000 times the chute gates have opened for bucking bulls of the year, veteran and rookie cowboy athletes alike.

Since 1986, Red Wilk Construction has been a corporate partner of the South Dakota State Fair. In 2001, when the Fair discontinued the PRCA rodeo held annually, Red decided to take on the task of bringing a professional level bull riding to the Grandstands.
