Welcome to Huron, the home of the 2025 South Dakota Class B Girls' State Basketball Tournament. Inside you'll find a profile of each team in the tournament as well as advertising from a host of local business supporting their teams in the tournament.

The 2025 tourney kicks off Thursday with the defending champion Centerville Tornadoes, undefeated on the season, facing the Deubrook Area Dolphins at noon (CT). That game will be followed by fourth-seeded Parkston Trojans squaring off with the fifth-seeded Bennett County Lady Warriors.

The evening session Thursday will open with second-seeded and undefeated Harding County. The Ranchers will tackle the St. Mary's Lady Cardinals beginning at 6 p.m. Following that game will be the Lyman Raiders, seeded third in the tournament, against the Sanborn Central/ Woonsocket Blackhawks.

The Huron Arena underwent some significant upgrades this year (below), and this tournament will be the first to truly get to experience the new signage throughout the arena, not just on the scoreboards.

The 2025 Centerville Tornadoes

The Centerville Tornadoes return to the 2025 state tournament as the defending champions, posting a 23-0 record in the 2024-2025 season and a 35-game win streak extending back to last season.

The Tornadoes have breezed through the regular season, averaging 61.6 points scored each game and only allowing 40.5 points per game. That ratio has actually improved in the postseason, as Centerville averaged a 26-point victory in three playoff games to earn a return trip to the state tourna-

This will be the fourth trip to the state tournament for the Tornadoes, with a runner-up finish in 2006, an appearance in 2011, and last season's championship.

Centerville is coached by Tucker Thornberg and holds the top overall seed in the tournament.



The Deubrook Area Dolphins make their first trip to the state tournament this season.

Coach Brad DeBeer has a young team, with just two seniors on the roster, but his top two scorers are sophomore Kylee Johnson and junior Matte Bauman.

The Dolphins have averaged 54.3 points on offense on the season while their pressing defense has allowed just 36.8 points per game to opponents.

They will hold the eighth seed in the tournament.

The Parkston Trojans return to the Class "B" State Tournament for the first time since 1981 as the fourth seed in the 2025 tourney.

The Trojans appeared nine times in the Class "A" tournament between appearances in the Class "B" tourney, with their best showing a runner-up finish in the 2012 A tournament.

The Trojans have played a schedule littered with top-tier teams this season. Parkston defeated two Class "B" state participants while falling to two 12-10-24...Kimball/White Lake, W 67-Class "A" teams in the state tourney. They also faced multiple teams who finished the year mentioned in state rankings but did not make it to the state tournament.

The Trojans are coached by Cole Knippling and feature a roster with three strong seniors but otherwise dominated by a host of sophomores.

No. 5 Bennett County Lady Warriors — 21-2

The Bennett County Lady Warriors return to the Class "B" State Tournament for the first time in 40 years, making their last appearance in the State B's in 1984. The school, located in Martin, will be making its seventh appearance in any state tournament, having made their last three appearances in the Class "A" tourney, winning a title in 1986.

The Lady Warriors have only lost twice this year, and both losses were to eventual state tournament teams, Dakota Valley, the second seed in Class A, and Lyman, the third seed in Class B. Bennett County is one of few

schools in the state who has scored 100 points in a game this year, accomplishing the feat on Jan. 21 against

Crazy Horse. The Lady Warriors are coached by Shawna Evans and are outscoring opponents by 30 points per game on average this season (61.3 points per game scoring versus 31.3 points per game allowed).




After taking home fourth place in the 2024 State Class "B" Tournament, the Lyman Raiders are back in the state tournament for the school's sixth appearance.


