





HURON — After playing the entire season at the junior varsity level last season, the Huron girls' golf team will delve

Now in his third season at the helm of the high school spring ball team, the continuity he hoped to instill between the Legion and spring ball program is

ented senior class. "Most of the seniors have been with me since I started," Babl recalled. "Add in Gabe Waldner, who came out last year for us, and we've got eight se-

niors on this year's team." Babl notes that his team enters the season with plenty of energy and expectation, but there are some challenges for the

coaches. "We've got a lot of different personalities that we have to mesh together. They know each other from other sports, so that's a good start," the coach explained. "They're coming off a big basketball season, so there's energy and excitement, but we have to harness that on the baseball field now, and there's some nuance to that.

The Tigers ran into weather issues the past few seasons that threatened their ability to participate

in the postseason, but Babl said they've intentionally scheduled to hopefully prevent that.

"We're away a lot this season, but those fields are turf fields, so we should be in good shape to get those games in," he said, explaining that Huron missed their first eight games of the season due to weather this year. "We scheduled heavy this year to help with that."

The top four hitters in batting average from last year's team return as seniors this year, led by Bubba Peterson, who led or tied for the team lead in batting average, doubles, and runs scored while finishing second in stolen bases. Trace Wenz returns to man the leadoff spot and center field for his final year as a Tiger.

The Tigers offer depth on the mound, led by staff ace, left-hander Jack Pederson. Pederson has been an impressive arm for Huron for multiple seasons and will now take the reins as the lead horse in the stable after a season when he was second in innings pitched with 20 1/3 and also had 20 strikeouts.

While putting together a varsity and a junior varsity roster both has been challenging in his first two seasons, Babl is excited to have a full JV that can allow for the development of younger players this season.

"We want to get everyone reps," he smiled. "There's some definite talent that will be playing JV all this year, but we will need them to step up next

The depth of the roster will also allow for flexibility in starting lineups depending on matchups.

The lack of winter and early spring moisture contributed to all home games being played by the varsity at Memorial Field this year, something that rarely

happens during spring season. Being able to play on the historic field is another thing that has his team fired up for the year, according to Babl.

"They're excited because they know that the fans get excited watching us play there," Babl commented. "It's a well-known place to play and definitely adds an atmosphere when we play there.

Babl identified sophomore Davis Chase as a top newcomer for the team. He joked that this could be one of the tallest Huron baseball teams in recent memory, led by the 6-foot-7 Chase.

Harrisburg, Brandon Valley, and Yankton, as well as the Sioux Falls schools, were identified as the teams that everyone will be chasing this year, according to Babl.

He's excited to see colleges show interest in the program and the players, and he credits the players for the progression of the program.

"It really comes down to kids that want to work and to work hard," Babl stated. "We have those kids that want to work hard, and it makes it fun to coach them."
