## Knob Noster Park campgrounds to reopen after \$1M renovation

**KNOB NOSTER** – Knob Noster State Park is reopening its campgrounds April 15 after a \$1 million restoration.

First closed in October 2022, a total renovation is nearly complete thanks to state construction crews. Knob Noster State Park Superintendent Daniel Brigman said a project consultant took plenty of time in the design phase to get things right.

“That was to make sure the end product would be as good as possible,” Brigman said. “We wanted to spend quality time to make sure we didn’t miss anything, and we covered everything possible with the funds we were allocated.”

Brigman said his team took most of the consultant’s suggestions.

On April 15, Phase One of the campground renovations will be complete, with 25 new sites open for campers.

“All of those sites have concrete pads,” Brigman said. “Seven of them will be full hookup, which means they’ll have water, sewer and electric, and all 25 sites will have 50-amp service.”

After 40 years, the campground had become less useable with the bigger recreational vehicles, many with slide-outs, awnings, and solar panels.

“So we reduced the number of campsites on that first half, simply to accommodate modern users,” Brigman said. “To make those concrete pads as effective as they could

be. Some of the sites before the upgrades, they were really narrow and not as long, so we were trying to get away from that, to make it as accommodating as possible.”

Brigman said planning for future campers was also the intent behind the redesigned sites.

“We’re trying to think ahead decades,” Brigman said. “What people are going to be using decades from now. This isn’t just meant for the next few years, so that was part of the design process.”

Six months spent in the planning and design phase shows in the beautiful layout of the area and the easy accessibility. Brigman said the funds were secured by Sen. Denny Hoskins, R-Warrensburg, and hopes that money will also be found for Phase Two.

“We’re estimating it’ll be around the same amount, about \$1 million,” Brigman said. “Eventually, we’ll get more funds – our local legislators, our central office, executive staff, we all are on the same page.”

And that includes making camping possible for everyone. Even those with oversized rigs.

“Camping is just getting to be a bigger and bigger pastime for people and justifiably so,” Brigman said. “We’re trying to make their visit as peaceful as it can be and accommodate what they’ve purchased to help their leisure activity.”

The showers were freshly renovated, and additional toilets were also added, some of which will be open year-round.

## PCAD receives new ambulance

**A**fter a two-year wait, the Pettis County Ambulance District has a new Ford E450 Super Duty Truck, fully equipped to care for patients. PCAD Truck No. 8 will replace a small, older van ambulance.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the subsequent supply chain disruption on the vehicle chassis, the truck wasn’t available when PCAD ordered it at the end of 2021. EMS Chief Roy Pennington said on Thursday, March 28, that they did a final inspection on the vehicle at the end of January, and it finally arrived at PCAD Headquarters on March 9.

“So, the truck it’s replacing is an older truck,” Pennington said. “Back in 2016, they wanted to try the vans out because they were a little cheaper and a little more economical on fuel.”

“But the downside, which was a big downside, was the lack of space in the back to conduct patient care,” he continued. “With the way those were set up, as far as having assistance back there and working with patients, honestly, there was room for one (emergency responder) and a half of another. It went well as far as how economical it was, but the functionality was not there.”

Pennington added that it’s his goal to have everything set up similarly. The 2017 trucks are basically the same as the new 2022 trucks.



The new 2022 Pettis County Ambulance District truck was ordered in 2021, but due to the COVID-19 pandemic affecting the supply chain, PCAD was unable to receive the truck until this month.

“There’s some safety things that have improved from 2017 to now,” he added. “And those things are in there but it’s not noticeable things as far as where equipment’s located, and where supplies are located,

and how the truck flows. “As far as maintenance, as the trucks get older, issues increase,” he continued. “And that ambulance that it’s replacing had almost 200,000 miles on it.”

## Open seats, primary challenges mean Senate will see high turnover

This year’s elections will result in some of the biggest changes in Missouri Senate membership since term limits took effect 20 years ago, with at least nine members exiting the chamber and primary challenges that could send four incumbents home.

The Senate, dominated by a Republican supermajority, is beset by GOP factional warfare that has disrupted both this year’s session and those of the past three years. A group that called itself the conservative caucus in 2021 and 2022, before rebranding as the Freedom Caucus, has repeatedly disrupted normal functioning of the Senate.

Filibusters held up ap-

proval of a new congressional district map and forced a special session on provider taxes vital to funding Medicaid. This year, the infighting became so bad several Freedom Caucus members lost committee chairmanships.

For the challengers to GOP incumbents, ending those fights is a theme they think will play with voters. “When we divide into sub-caucuses, it hurts the conservative agenda,” said state Rep. Mike Haffner of Pleasant Hill, who is challenging state Sen. Rick Brattin in the 21st District. “I belong to the conservative party, the Republican Party, and that’s the only group that I will affiliate with.”

With most seats considered safe for one party or

the other and only half of the chamber on the ballot, there is little chance Republicans will lose their majority. Three open seats are considered toss-ups, however, and could end the GOP supermajority if Democrats have a good year.

The turnover this year is comparable to what happened when term limits took effect in 2002. Senators can serve two four-year terms, and that year 12 were ineligible to run for re-election. Ten more were barred from new terms in 2004.

Of the nine members leaving the chamber this year, six must exit due to term limits. Among the others, Sen. Elaine Gannon of De Soto is retiring, Sen. Holly Thompson Rehder

of Scott City is running for lieutenant governor and state Sen. Karla Eslinger of Wasola will take over as the state’s Commissioner of Education on June 1.

Across the Capitol in the Missouri House, where all the seats are on the ballot, there is a big increase in contested seats compared to two years ago. In the 2022 election, only 69 of 163 districts had both Republican and Democratic candidates. This year, the major parties will both field candidates in 114 districts.

To break the Republican supermajority in the Missouri House, Democrats would have to pick up three seats, which they did in the 2022 elections.

## Former Sen. Joe Lieberman dead at 82

HARTFORD, Conn. — Former U.S. Sen. Joe Lieberman of Connecticut, who nearly won the vice presidency on the Democratic ticket with Al Gore in the disputed 2000 election and who almost became Republican John McCain's running mate eight years later, has died, according to a statement issued by his family.

Lieberman died in New York City on Wednesday due to complications from a fall, the statement said. He was 82.

The Democrat-turned-independent was never shy about veering from the party line.

Lieberman's independent streak and especially his needling of Democratic presidential nominee Barack Obama during the 2008 presidential contest ranked many Democrats, the party he aligned with in the Senate. Yet his support for gay rights, civil rights, abortion rights and environmental causes at times won him the praise of many liberals over the years.

"In an era of political carbon copies, Joe Lieberman was a singularity. One of one," said Connecticut Sen. Chris Murphy, a Democrat. "He fought and won for what he believed was right and for the state he adored."

Over the last decade, Lieberman helped lead No Labels, a centrist third-party movement that has said it will offer as-yet-unnamed candidates for president and vice president this year. Some groups aligned with Democrats oppose the effort, fearing it will help presumptive Republican nominee Donald Trump win the White House.

The group on Wednesday called Lieberman's unexpected death a "profound loss," describing him as "a singular figure in American political life who always put his country before party."

Lieberman came tantalizingly close to winning the vice presidency in the contentious 2000 presidential contest that was decided by a 537-vote margin victory for George W. Bush in Florida after a drawn-out recount, legal challenges and a Supreme Court decision. He was the first Jewish candidate on a major party's presidential ticket and would have been the first Jewish vice president.

Gore said in a statement Wednesday night that he was profoundly saddened by the death of his one-time running mate. He called Lieberman "a truly gifted leader, whose affable

personality and strong will made him a force to be reckoned with" and said his dedication to equality and fairness started at a young age, noting Lieberman traveled to the South to join the civil rights movement in the 1960s.

"It was an honor to stand side-by-side with him on the campaign trail," Gore said.

Lieberman sought the Democratic presidential nomination in 2004 but dropped out after a weak showing in the early primaries. Four years later, he was an independent who was nearly chosen to be McCain's running mate. He and McCain were close pals who shared hawkish views on military and national security matters.

McCain was leaning strongly toward choosing Lieberman for the ticket as the 2008 GOP convention neared, but he chose Sarah Palin at the last minute after "ferocious" blowback from conservatives over Lieberman's liberal record, according to Steve Schmidt, who managed McCain's campaign.

Lieberman generated controversy in 1998 when he scolded President Bill Clinton, his friend of many years, for "disgraceful behavior" in an explosive speech on the Senate floor during the height of the scandal over his relationship with Monica Lewinsky. Yet Lieberman later voted against the impeachment of Clinton.

While he had a tortured relationship with Democrats, Lieberman defended his partisan switches as a matter of conscience, saying he always had the best interests of Connecticut voters at heart. Critics accused him of pursuing narrow self-interest and political expediency.

In announcing his retirement from the Senate in 2013, Lieberman acknowledged that he did "not always fit comfortably into conventional political boxes" and felt his first responsibility was to serve his constituents, state and country, not his political party.

During his final Senate speech, Lieberman urged Congress to look beyond party lines and partisan rancor to break Washington gridlock.

"It requires reaching across the aisle and finding partners from the opposite party," said Lieberman. "That is what is desperately needed in Washington now."

Nevada Sen. Harry Reid, who served as Senate Dem-

ocratic leader, once said that while he didn't always agree with the independent-minded Lieberman, he respected him.

"Regardless of our differences, I have never doubted Joe Lieberman's principles or his patriotism," Reid said. "And I respect his independent streak, as it stems from strong convictions."

Privately, some Democrats were often less charitable about Lieberman's forays across party lines, which they saw as disloyal. He bolted his party and turned independent after a 2006 Senate primary loss in Connecticut.

Lieberman's strong support of the Iraq War had hurt his statewide popularity. Democrats rejected Lieberman and handed the 2006 primary to a political newcomer and an antiwar candidate, Ned Lamont, who is now serving a second term as Connecticut governor. Citing his Senate experience, congressional clout and support for the state's defense industry, Lieberman went on to win reelection to a fourth term as an independent.

Many of his Democratic allies and longtime friends, including former Sen. Chris Dodd, had supported Lamont in that election. Lieberman was candid about what he considered a betrayal by old pals such as Dodd, but the two men later reconciled.

In a statement issued Wednesday expressing condolences, Lamont said he and Lieberman eventually became friends after their grueling and contentious race.

"While the senator and I had our political differences, he was a man of integrity and conviction, so our debate about the Iraq War was serious," Lamont said in a statement. "I believe we agreed to disagree from a position of principle."

"When the race was over, we stayed in touch as friends in the best traditions of American democracy. He

will be missed," he added.

After his rebound reelection in 2006, Lieberman decided to caucus with Democrats in the Senate, who let him head a committee in return because they needed his vote to help keep control of the closely divided chamber. But it wasn't long until Lieberman was showing his independent streak and ruffling his Democratic caucus colleagues.

He was an enthusiastic backer of McCain in the 2008 presidential contest, and his speech at the 2008 GOP presidential nominating convention criticizing Obama, the Democratic presidential nominee, struck a deep nerve.

Lieberman cast Obama as a political show horse, a lightweight with a thin record of accomplishment in the Senate despite his soaring eloquence as a speaker.

"In the Senate, during the 3 1/2 years that Sen. Obama has been a member, he has not reached across party lines to ... accomplish anything significant, nor has he been willing to take on powerful interest groups in the Democratic Party to get something done," Lieberman said at the convention.

"Eloquence is no substitute for a record," he said.

Lieberman campaigned heartily across the country for McCain. Many Democrats considered it a betrayal of Obama and his former party colleagues.

"Joe Lieberman has said things that are totally irresponsible when it comes to Barack Obama," House Democratic leader Nancy Pelosi of California said in a radio interview during the 2008 race. In a message posted Wednesday on X, Pelosi called Lieberman a "leader of integrity and patriotism" while acknowledging they often disagreed on politics.

## Not all vegetables are annuals. Here are some that come back year after year

Most vegetables grown in home gardens are annuals. They wither and die at the end of the season and need to be replanted every year to reap more crops.

But if you're short on time or money, don't want to be bothered with yearly planting or want to try something new, I've got just the plants for you: perennial vegetables.

### PREPARING THE SOIL

If you ever were to prioritize improving your soil, it should be before planting perennials. Since the bed will contain plants for years to come, it's the only chance you'll get to truly mix in compost or manure, till in amendments to adjust the soil's pH and properly dig weeds up by their roots without the risk of disturbing nearby plants.

It's also an excellent time to incorporate an organic fertilizer. Just as a house needs a good foundation, healthy plants begin with healthy soil. Seize the opportunity while you have it.

One benefit of growing perennial crops is that they're generally low maintenance. Once you've planted a crop, there will be no need to plant it again, so you won't find yourself tilling, turning or digging the soil again for as long as they are in your garden.

Going forward, sprinkle an inch or two of compost and, in most cases, a dose of fertilizer granules over the soil every spring.

Just as when growing ornamental perennials, be sure to confirm that your growing conditions match your chosen plants' individual requirements, such as cold hardiness, pH range, sunlight exposure and water needs.

### GIVING THEM TIME

Some perennial vegetables should be allowed to become fully established in the garden before harvesting.

Asparagus, for instance, is an exercise in patience. Plants should be allowed to grow undisturbed for two full years before harvesting.

Plant in spring, and when third-year stalks are 6-10 inches tall, use a sharp knife to cut each slightly below the soil line. Stop harvesting in early July to allow plants to store up the energy required for next year's crop. (Perennial in zones 3-8)

Rhubarb also shouldn't be harvested immediately. You can, however, sample up to four stalks per plant in their second year. Plant bare-root crowns, with their buds, or "eyes," facing upward, 2 inches below the soil surface in either spring or fall, allowing 3-4 feet between plants. Starting in their third year, harvest stalks when they are between 12 and 18 inches long, but never remove more than two-thirds of each plant. (Perennial in zones 3-8)

### QUICKER GRATIFICATION

Jerusalem artichokes - also called sunchokes - are quick-spreading plants that can take over a garden bed, so consider growing them in their own space. Plant 3-5 inches deep and 12-18 inches apart in early spring. The easy-to-grow plants aren't particular about soil type and don't need annual fertilization, but they

cannot tolerate soggy soils. Harvest tubers in autumn, preferably after a couple of light frosts, which will improve their flavor. But allow some to remain in the ground to produce next year's crop. (Perennial in zones 3-8)

Egyptian walking onions are unusual, fun-to-grow onions that spread as they "walk" across the garden bed. Not considered invasive because they can be easily controlled (unwanted plants pull up easily), these onions grow clusters of small bulbils (secondary bulbils that grow at the top of the plan) at the top of their stalks. When they become too heavy for the plant to bear, the stalks bend over, resting the bulbils on the soil surface. Before long, the bulbils root and grow into new plants. Harvest bulbils anytime and use as you would onions, or dig up full-size onions in late summer, allowing some to remain in the ground for next year. (Perennial in zones 3-9)

## Back from the dead

Gary Habermas, the expert on Jesus' resurrection, lost his wife to cancer at 43. Gary went through all of the emotions of grief and mourning. This included asking God why. He imagined that God would say, "Gary, did I raise my Son from the dead?" Gary would wonder why Debbie is dying. "Gary, did I raise my Son from the dead?" Gary recognized that Jesus had been raised from the dead, so he could trust that he and Debbie would be together again for all eternity. This Sunday is a reminder that this life is not all there is.

That is if we repent of our sins. If we believe Jesus is the Son of God, that he lived a perfect life, died on the cross, and was raised again three days later, conquering sin and death, we will be saved. That is the only way to know for sure that we will spend eternity with Jesus and those loved ones who believed in Jesus before death. I look forward to the day when I will meet Jesus face to face and see those I love who have passed.

In Luke 7:11-17, Jesus encounters a funeral of the only son of a widow. He would have died that morning, and her grief would have been raw and fresh. The mother leads the funeral procession. In Galilee, a woman led be-

Jesus died for you and me, so if we put our faith in him alone, we will be saved once and for all. I am thankful for the compassion Jesus has taken on me, a sinner. It means that I look for ways to show compassion to others or to support compassionate organizations. How can you show compassion this weekend to someone who is hurting?

Most surveys about fear say that the greatest fear is death. If you

believe this life is all there is, I would be afraid too. I am not afraid because I know that this life does not end with my death. I know I will spend an eternity in heaven with Jesus because I have placed my faith in Jesus alone. I do not want the other option, when we choose not to believe, that is to spend an eternity separated from God in hell. Jesus rescues us from our greatest fear, death.

We must do as Paul reminds us in Romans 10:9, "because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

This Sunday reminds us that Jesus embodies God's care for us. The crowds reacted by saying two things. Jesus is a great prophet because of the miracle of bringing the young man back to life. The second was God had visited them that day in Jesus. They were starting to understand and believe that Jesus was the Messiah and their Savior.

I pray that if you do not believe in Jesus, you will put your faith in him. God cares for you on the good days and the bad ones. In the midst of suffering and when you do not feel you are worthy, God loves and cares for you as his creation. I hope you will join us at Maplewood Church this weekend if you do not have a church.

## UN court orders Israel to open more crossings for Gaza aid

THE HAGUE, Netherlands — The top United Nations court on Thursday ordered Israel to take measures to improve the humanitarian situation in Gaza, including opening more land crossings to allow food, water, fuel and other supplies into the war-ravaged enclave.

The International Court of Justice issued two new so-called provisional measures in a case brought by South Africa accusing Israel of acts of genocide in its military campaign launched after the Oct. 7 attacks by Hamas. Israel denies it is committing genocide. It says its military campaign is self defense and aimed at Hamas, not the Palestinian people.

Thursday's order came after South Africa sought more provisional measures, including a cease-fire, citing starvation in Gaza. Israel urged the court not to issue new orders.

In its legally binding order, the court told Israel to take measures "without delay" to ensure "the unhindered provision" of basic services and humanitarian assistance, including food, water, fuel and medical supplies.

It also ordered Israel to immediately ensure that its military does not take action that could harm Palestinians' rights under the Genocide Convention, including by preventing the delivery of humanitarian assistance.

The court told Israel to report back in a month on its implementation of the orders.

Israel declared war in response to a bloody cross-border attack by Hamas on Oct. 7 in which 1,200 people were killed and 250 others were taken hostage. Israel responded with a campaign of airstrikes and a ground

offensive that have left over 32,000 Palestinians dead, according to local health authorities. The fighting also displaced over 80% of Gaza's population and caused widespread damage.

The U.N. and international aid agencies say virtually the entire Gaza population is struggling to get enough food, with hundreds of thousands of people on the brink of famine, especially in hard-hit northern Gaza.

South Africa welcomed Thursday's decision, calling it "significant."

"The fact that Palestinian deaths are not solely caused by bombardment and ground attacks, but also by disease and starvation, indicates a need to protect the group's right to exist," the South African president said in a statement.

Hamas said in an online statement that the ruling must be enforced by the international community.

"It must be implemented immediately, so that this decision does not remain a dead letter," the militant group said.

The Palestinian Foreign Ministry thanked South Africa, calling the case "a vital step in the global effort to hold Israel accountable for perpetrating genocide."

The Israeli Foreign Ministry had no immediate comment.

In a written response earlier this month to South Africa's request for more measures, Israel said the claims by South Africa were "wholly unfounded," "morally repugnant" and "an abuse both of the Genocide Convention and of the Court itself."

After initially sealing Gaza's borders in the early days of the war, Israel began to permit entry of humanitarian supplies. It says it places no restrictions on the amount of humanitarian aid allowed into Gaza and accuses the

United Nations of failing to properly organize the deliveries.

The U.N. and international aid groups say deliveries have been impeded by Israeli military restrictions, ongoing hostilities and the breakdown of public order.

Israel has been working with international partners on a plan to soon begin deliveries of aid by sea.

Israel has repeatedly feuded with the United Nations, particularly UNRWA, the U.N. agency for Palestinian refugees and main provider of aid in Gaza. Israel accuses the agency of tolerating and even cooperating with Hamas — a charge UNRWA denies.

The court said in its order that "Palestinians in Gaza are no longer facing only a risk of famine ... but that famine is setting in." It cited a report from the United Nations Office for Humanitarian Affairs that said at least 31 people, including 27 children, have already died of malnutrition and dehydration.

The world court said earlier orders imposed on Israel after landmark hearings in South Africa's case "do not fully address the consequences arising from the changes in the situation" in Gaza.

On Tuesday, the army said it inspected 258 aid trucks, but only 116 were distributed within Gaza by the U.N.

COGAT, the Israeli military body in charge of Palestinian civilian affairs, has also run pilot programs to inspect the humanitarian aid at Israel's main checkpoints in the south and then use land crossings in central Gaza to try to bring aid to the devastated northern part of the Strip. The agency had no immediate comment on the ICJ ruling.

## US changes how it categorizes people by race and ethnicity

ORLANDO, Fla. — For the first time in 27 years, the U.S. government is changing how it categorizes people by race and ethnicity, an effort that federal officials believe will more accurately count residents who identify as Hispanic and of Middle Eastern and North African heritage.

The revisions to the minimum categories on race and ethnicity, announced Thursday by the Office of Management and Budget, are the latest effort to label and define the people of the United States. This evolving process often reflects changes in social attitudes and immigration, as well as a wish for people in an increasingly diverse society to see themselves

in the numbers produced by the federal government.

"You can't underestimate the emotional impact this has on people," said Meeta Anand, senior director for Census & Data Equity at The Leadership Conference on Civil and Human Rights. "It's how we conceive ourselves as a society. ... You are seeing a desire for people to want to self-identify and be re-

flected in data so they can tell their own stories."

Under the revisions, questions about race and ethnicity that previously were asked separately on forms will be combined into a single question. That will give respondents the option to pick multiple categories at the same time, such as "Black," "American Indian" and "Hispanic." Research has shown that large numbers of Hispanic people aren't sure how to answer the race question when that question is asked separately because they understand race and ethnicity to be similar and they often pick "some other race" or do not answer the question.

A Middle Eastern and North African category will be added to the choices available for questions about race and ethnicity. People descended from places such as Lebanon, Iran, Egypt and Syria had been encouraged to identify as white, but now will have the option of identifying themselves in the new group. Results from the 2020 census, which asked respondents to elaborate on their backgrounds, suggest that 3.5 million residents identify as Middle Eastern and North African.

"It feels good to be seen," said Florida state

Rep. Anna Eskamani, a Democrat from Orlando whose parents are from Iran. "Growing up, my family would check the 'white' box because we didn't know what other box reflected our family. Having representation like that, it feels meaningful."

The changes also strike from federal forms the words "Negro" and "Far East," now widely regarded as pejorative, as well as the terms "majority" and "minority," because they fail to reflect the nation's complex racial and ethnic diversity, some officials say. The revisions also encourage the collection of detailed race and ethnicity data beyond the minimum standards, such as "Haitian" or "Jamaican" for someone who checks "Black."

Grouping together people of different backgrounds into a single race and ethnicity category, such as Japanese and Filipino in the Asian classification, often masks disparities in income or health, and advocates argued having the detailed data will allow the information about the subgroups to be separated out in a process called disaggregation.

"To be able to disaggregate can really be helpful to distinguish different kinds of discrimination, the ability to enforce laws

around discrimination and do research on public health and economic outcomes," said Allison Pleyer, chief demographer of The Data Center in New Orleans.

The changes to the standards were hammered out over two years by a group of federal statisticians and bureaucrats who prefer to stay above the political fray. But the revisions have long-term implications for legislative redistricting, civil rights laws, health statistics, and possibly even politics as the number of people categorized as white is reduced.

Donald Trump, the presumptive GOP nominee for president, recently alluded to arguments made by people who allege Democrats are promoting illegal immigration to weaken the power of white people. As president, Trump unsuccessfully tried to disqualify people who were in the United States illegally from being included in the 2020 census.

Momentum for changing the race and ethnicity categories grew during the Obama administration in the mid-2010s, but was halted after Trump became president in 2017. It was revived after Democratic President Joe Biden took office in 2021.



And it actually ended up having some catastrophic motor problems. It will still run, but we wouldn't want to use it as an ambulance — it would cost thousands of dollars to fix it."

Safety features in the newer trucks' patient compartments include harnesses for paramedics and EMTs instead of lap belts. A bar at the end of the bench seat was replaced with a safety net, and crash-rated mounts for the cardiac monitors and ventilators were

installed. "So, it's all mounted to the wall," Pennington explained. "It's safe. The other thing that we added was the power load."

On the older trucks, emergency responders had to lift the patient bed in and out of the truck themselves. With the push of a button, the power load does all the work for them, saving many back injuries.

"So, we really don't have that issue too much anymore," he noted. "We still have to lift patients, but it's not as common as it used to be."

Workers Mike Thompson and Connor Ralston were painting the parking area and hosing off the freshly poured cement pads Thursday, March 28.

"Just cleaning it up and sprucing it up," Thompson said. "Doing the stripes, doing the ADA parking, cleaning up the stuff."

Thompson had been pulled off working on the Katy Trail to help with the last push to finish the campground. He is especially proud of the concrete work.

"With the new concrete pours, everything is on ADA slopes," Thompson explained, "and we have ADA fire rings, they're higher fire rings."

The ground has been graded and spread with grass seed just in time for camping season.

A big draw to the park is the seven hiking trails, and Brigman said a new trail is being blazed, due to open in September.

Legislative candidates accounted for 410 of the more than 580 candidates who visited the Secretary of State's office — some more than once — to put their names on the ballot for posts ranging from circuit judge to governor.

### GOP majorities are safe

The reason Republicans seem certain to retain their Senate majority after this year's election is the seats that aren't on the ballot. The partisan split in this year's state Senate elections is seven Democratic seats and 10 Republican. Of the seats not on the ballot, three are held by Democrats and 14 by Republicans.

Every one of the 17 Senate seats on this year's ballot has a contest. Three, the 13th District in St. Louis County, the 27th District of southeast Missouri and the 33rd District in southwest Missouri only have a primary.

Until Tuesday, it looked like Democrats would pick up a Republican-held seat with the close of filing. Former state Rep. Stephen Webber of Columbia was unopposed in the 19th District, currently held by Senate President Pro Tem Caleb Rowden, until former state Rep. Chuck Basye filed.

The Senate seats expected to be competitive in November are open because of term limits. Two are currently held by Democrats, State Sen. Lauren Arthur of Kansas City in the 17th District and Senate Minority Leader John Rizzo of Independence in the 11th District.

The third is held by a Republican, state Sen. Andrew Koenig of Manchester in the 15th District. Koenig is a candidate for state treasurer.

The incumbent senators facing primaries include two of the chamber's most conservative members, Brattin of Harrisonville and Mike Moon of Ash Grove, and two first-term Democrats, Barbara Washington of Kansas City and Angela Moseley of Florissant.

Mosley represents the 13th District and her primary against state Rep. Chantelle Nickson-Clark of Florissant will decide who is sworn in as senator in January.

The Democratic primary in Kansas City's 9th District will pit Washington against Brandon Ellington, a former state representative and former Kansas City councilman. He's not running because of any particular beef with Washington, he said, except he thinks he could do more.

"I am not running against the Senator, I'm running for the Senate seat, because we need a senator that's actually going to fight for the residents of the 9th district and have an understanding of suffering across the state," Ellington said.

Washington, interviewed outside her Capitol office, said she's brought millions of dollars home for projects important to her district and pointed to the revitalization of the historic Black business district of 18th and Vine.

"He should look at my record," she said.

Republican Derron Black of Kansas City will face the winner in November.

### Challenging the Freedom Caucus

For Republican incumbents facing a primary, the campaign is opening with heavy criticism from opponents. Challengers said they want to cooperate with GOP leadership in the chamber, not spend days tying the

chamber up. Moon spends too much time obstructing the Senate and too little time working to get his bills passed, said Susan Haralson of Ozark, founder of Premier Home Health Care who has filed to run against Moon in the GOP primary.

Moon represents the 29th District in southwest Missouri.

Moon was a member of the conservative caucus, a group formed in 2021 that also engaged in bitter factional fights, though he is not a formal member of the current iteration of the group called the Freedom Caucus. He often challenges Senate custom, including a 2022 episode when he was punished for wearing overalls on the Senate floor and refusing to apologize for breaking decorum.

"He is truly a nice guy," Haralson said of Moon. "I just think that he's a little off base."

Haralson said she wants the Senate to function as a collegial body, not one where factions disrupt debate.

"I don't think there's much that has been accomplished," she said. "And some of it is because of him."

In 12 years as a lawmaker, including eight years in the House, Moon has passed one bill, to ban gender-affirming medical treatments for minors. It passed last year.

"That is a significant bill passed that will live on way longer than I'll be alive, and it's for the protection of children," Moon said. "I think that's a substantial benchmark."

The 29th district was redrawn after the census to include Christian County, where he has never been on the ballot, and to remove Stone and Taney counties,

which he carried in his 2020 primary. Haralson lives in Christian County.

Ron Monnig of Eagle Rock filed Tuesday as the Democratic candidate in the 29th District to face the winner of the Moon-Haralson primary in November.

Brattin's primary opponents in the 21st District in western Missouri are both currently members of the House: Haffner and Dan Houx of Warrensburg.

Brattin won the primary for his seat in 2020 with 49.6% of the vote and placed second in the 4th Congressional District primary in 2022. He is a member of the Freedom Caucus and lost a committee chairmanship and two vice-chairmanships when Senate leaders lost patience with the caucus' obstruction tactics.

"It's sad to me that there are bills that have been in the process over the past three years that died in the last couple of weeks in the Senate that should have passed," said Houx.

Haffner blames obstruction for the low number of bills passed in recent years.

"Some of the actions that are being taken on the floor are dysfunctional, and it is hurting the opportunity to get the conservative agenda to the governor," Haffner said.

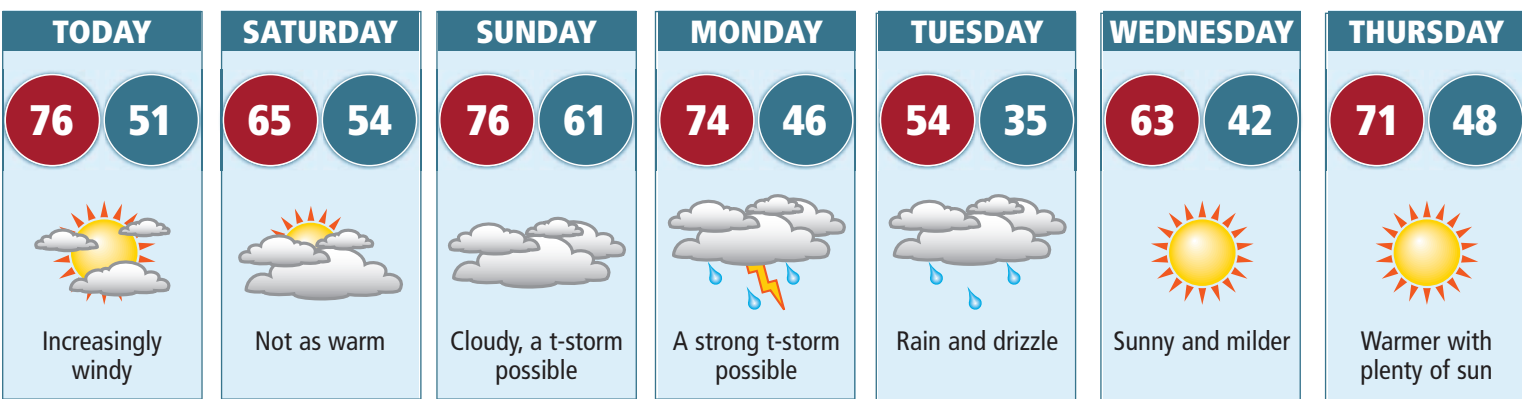
Brattin had equally sharp words for his opponents.

The 31st District was redrawn after the census, adding Johnson County to Cass and Bates counties and removing Barton, Henry and Vernon counties. That moved Houx out of his previous district, the 21st, represented by Sen. Denny Hoskins of Warrensburg.

"He feels like this is his anointing and it was his rightful office up until redistricting," Brattin said.

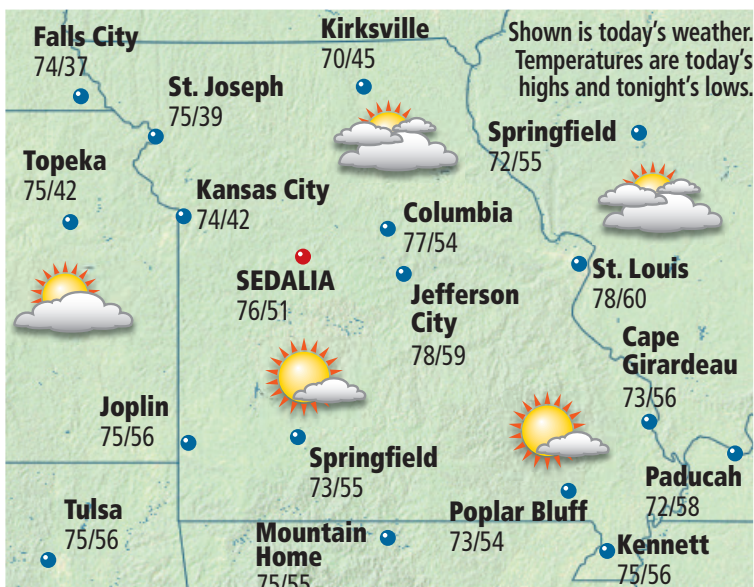

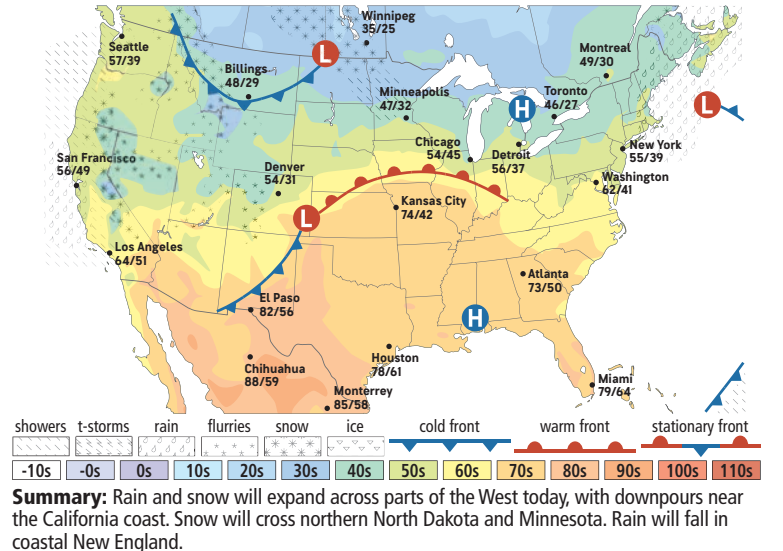

## Glen Taylor will no longer sell Timberwolves

MINNEAPOLIS — The ownership transfer of the Minnesota Timberwolves slammed to a halt when Glen Taylor declared on Thursday he won't take the final step of his drawn-out \$1.5 billion deal to hand Marc Lore and Alex Rodriguez the majority stake because they didn't meet all of the deadlines in the sale conditions.

Lore and Rodriguez, who agreed to the purchase nearly three years ago, strongly disputed Taylor's stance. They said he simply had cold feet about letting go.

"We went through the process, and I spent a lot of time. We've got a really good team, we've got a lot of good things going for us, I enjoy it and I'm healthy enough to do this," Taylor said in an interview with The Associated Press after the announcement. "I don't need

the money, so I think I'll just keep running it and enjoy it. I like my coach. I like my staff. This way everybody gets to keep their jobs, and I'll be happy."

Lore, the e-commerce entrepreneur, and Rodriguez, the former Major League Baseball star, is-

sued a joint statement expressing disappointment in Taylor and contending that they've upheld their end of the deal that was also include the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx. Lore and Rodriguez already own a 40% stake.

"We have fulfilled our obligations, have all necessary funding and are fully committed to closing our purchase of the team as soon as the NBA completes its approval process," the partners said. "Glen Taylor's statement is an unfortunate case of seller's remorse that is short sighted and disruptive to the team and the fans during an historic winning season."

The Timberwolves (50-22) beat Detroit on Wednesday to reach the 50-win mark for just the fifth time in the 35-year history of the franchise. They're tied for second place in the Western Conference with Oklahoma City, a half-game behind Denver.

Taylor, who turns 83 on April 20, bought the Timberwolves for \$88 million in 1994 to keep them in his native Minnesota after a deal the previous owners struck to move the team to New Orleans fell through. He's a self-made billionaire who grew up on a farm and became a printing magnate after a job at a wedding invitations shop he got to put himself through college took off.

Before Lore and Rodriguez entered the picture, Taylor had flirted with selling multiple times only to pull the club off the market. After reaching the agreement, Taylor raved about the connection he made with them and how comfortable he felt handing over the reins to them. They bought 20% of the franchise in 2021 and another 20% in 2023.

The unique and deliberate transfer was orchestrated by both parties, giving Taylor the opportunity to not only ease his way out of a role he has treasured since rescuing the struggling franchise but to serve as a mentor to the incoming owners about the business of the league and the culture of the community.

Lore previously served as Walmart's e-commerce chief and left that post shortly before the purchase agreement with Taylor. He is currently the CEO of Wonder, a food delivery startup in New York.

Rodriguez ranks fifth on baseball's all-time home run list and has become an investor in a variety of businesses since his playing career. He's also a trustee at the University of Miami.

Lore and Rodriguez unsuccessfully tried to purchase the New York Mets before Steve Cohen bought the MLB club in 2020. In an interview with the AP in 2022, Rodriguez said the NBA had welcomed him into the ownership world with open arms.

"It's all about the fans in Minnesota. I think they deserve a winner," Rodriguez said in that interview.

The partners exercised their option on Dec. 28 to buy another 40% and become controlling owners, and the agreement gave them a 90-day window to close the sale that expired on Wednesday. Taylor said he decided to void the contract for this third and final portion of the sale because Lore and Rodriguez missed certain deadlines related to the closing process.

# Braves ace Strider aims for dominant 2024

ATLANTA — Spencer Strider is one of baseball's most dominant pitchers.

That's not enough for him.

The Atlanta Braves ace is looking to make things even tougher on anyone who steps up against him in 2024.

Still miffed about the way last season ended, with another loss to the Philadelphia Phillies in the NL Division Series, Strider spent spring training working on a curveball that could make his repertoire nastier than it already is.

"In sort of analyzing the way the season ended last year and the season as a whole, the outcome is that we were not — and myself in particular — we were not as good as we needed to be to complete our ultimate goal of winning the World Series," Strider said. "You start addressing that by improving where you can. One of the ways I could improve was to try to adopt this curveball."

In his first full season as a starting pitcher, Strider certainly had plenty of reasons to be proud of himself. He was baseball's lone 20-game winner, finished fourth in the NL Cy Young voting and broke Hall of Famer John Smoltz's fran-

chise record for strikeouts in a season by punching out 281 hitters.

But Strider lost both starts in the NL Division Series against the rival Phillies, including the decisive Game 4 in raucous Philadelphia, where he surrendered three runs in 5 2/3 innings — all of them on solo homers.

While his career record in the regular season is a dazzling 37-10, Strider has yet to win in the postseason, also getting roughed up by the Phillies in his lone start of the 2022 NLDS.

"My job as a pitcher is to help us win games, win championships," he said. "No one is giving you a trophy for winning 162 games. That's kind of the perspective I have. Because this is a team sport, my job is to contribute to the collective goal of trying to win a team trophy. That's the World Series."

The 25-year-old Strider can be downright unhit-table at times, possessing a 100-mph fastball augmented by one of the game's best sliders. But, as the postseason has shown, two great pitches aren't always enough.

So Strider broke out a sharper-breaking curve in spring training, giving batters something else to think about. The results were stunning.

In 22 2/3 innings over six appearances, he surrendered just two runs on 15 hits, with a whopping 35 strikeouts.

"It's a pitch that kind of fits my arsenal well," Strider said, "It's something that I've used before. Picking it up wasn't that difficult necessarily. That's the perspective I had on it. How could I get better?"

He wasn't focused on adding more strikeouts to his already daunting total from 2023, though it certainly appears feasible that he could become just the 20th pitcher in baseball's modern era to reach 300 Ks in a season.

"I don't think that was necessarily my justification behind it or my thought process," Strider said. "It was just adding a tool to my toolbox in a way. If I was able to, I would go out and learn every pitch that's ever been conceived of and have that at my disposal. But I can't do that. This is something that fits my strengths and my capabilities, so it made sense to try to incorporate it."

Manager Brian Snitker was not surprised that Strider — already well known for his intense workout routine, strict dietary regimen and eclectic thought process, not to mention that bushy mustache — decided to work on a new pitch.

"I don't think he'll ever be satisfied with what he's doing," Snitker said. "He's one of those guys who's always gonna be looking to get better, to improve, for an edge. It's what makes those guys really good."

Of course, spring games don't count. That all changes on Thursday, weather permitting, when Strider gets the honor of making the first opening day start of his career in Philadelphia, again facing the team that ended Atlanta's season far earlier than expected the last two Octobers.

"If spring training outcomes carried over to the regular season," he said, "we'd have a lot of misplaced confidence."

Strider is not going to get too carried away with what happens in the first game, though he's thrilled to get the nod on opening day for the six-time reigning NL East champions, whose impressive rotation also includes Max Fried, Chris Sale and Charlie Morton.

"We all know that what happens on opening day will be forgotten pretty quickly if we're where we want to be six months from now," Strider said. "This is a beginning of a slow march toward a goal we've had our eyes on all spring."

Rees-Zammit ran an official time of 4.43 in the 40-yard dash last week when the international players participated in the University of South Florida's pro day. He drew a lot of attention from a crowd that included 51 scouts from 31 teams.

"A bit disappointed in my 40," Rees-Zammit told the AP afterward. "Last week, I was getting some really good times. I was getting low 4.3s, high 4.2s. So it is what it is. It's just what happens on the day. But I know I can run that fast. I'm not trying to make excuses or anything, but I know what I can do and I'm happy with the day and how the day went."

Rees-Zammit, whose favorite NFL player growing up was three-time Pro Bowl wide receiver

DeSean Jackson, hopes to play like 49ers stars Deebo Samuel and Christian McCaffrey.

"I watched a lot of footage of Deebo Samuel, Christian McCaffrey, players like that who've got that versatility because I want to be a player that can play multiple positions and I fully believe I can, so being able to play out of the backfield, being able to line up as a receiver, in the slot, wideout," Rees-Zammit said last week. "I've learned a lot in the past eight weeks and I'm pretty excited to see what will happen."

He'll get an opportunity to catch passes from three-time Super Bowl MVP Patrick Mahomes and learn from coach Andy Reid. The NFL's new kickoff rule that makes returners more relevant gives Rees-Zammit a chance to make the team as a specialist.

For the first time this

season, each team will have a 17th roster spot on the practice squad specifically available for an international player. Teams also are permitted to promote an international practice squad player to the active roster a

maximum of three times throughout the season — increasing opportunities for players to develop and get a chance to play.

Teams will also receive one training camp roster exemption for a qualifying international player.

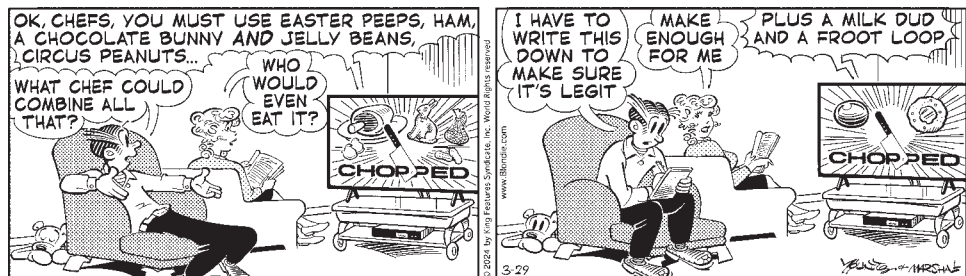
