WELCOME TO THE UPPER CUMBERLAND REGIONAL AIRPORT

The Upper Cumberland Air Fair began as a way to engage the local communities in showcasing the abilities of our airport.

Upper Cumberland Regional Airport is co-owned by the City of Sparta, White County, the City of Cookeville, and Putnam County. It is managed by the UCRA Board of Directors consisting of representatives from all four local governments.

The airport is currently home to approximately 125 based aircraft and boasts a 6,704-foot runway capable of up to 400,000-pound aircraft operations, the longest and heaviest nontowered airfield in the state.

The airport provides aircraft ground handling, freight handling, military support, law enforcement support, and fueling

services covering a wide range of aircraft through the Fixed Base Operator (FBO), which is operated and managed by the airport board. There are two independent aircraft maintenance shops, two aircraft brokerage operators, medical helicopter operations with maintenance shop, two flight schools, and several other flight departments that operate from the airport.

Operation counts have steadily increased as the area has grown. We currently rank as one of the busier general aviation airports in the state, and Tennessee Department of Transportation's 2019 Tennessee aviation system plan found the airport contributed \$19.7 million to the local economy, in 2019.

As many are aware, we are in the beginning steps of preparing

for possible commercial service. This requires a lot of internal planning and coordination, but our feasibility study predicted strong demand. From an airfield standpoint, we currently handle many business jets that are as large or larger than the regional jets that are utilized for commercial service.

The commercial service implementation team has been formed and will begin evaluations later this year. This is a long process that may take several years to materialize, but I gain more confidence in our direction with each hurdle we bass.

YOU CAN RIDE IN A HOT AIR BALLOON

Few things rival the serenity and beauty of hot air balloons, and we have them as a feature of our 2022 Upper Cumberland Air Fair. On Friday night, you can see a spectacular sight as the balloons light up the sky in gorgeous color within a Night Glow presentation, and you can get a tethered ride or even a full-experience flight in one of these awesome balloons.

PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY ON SATURDAY, AS WE EXPECT RIDES TO SELL OUT QUICKLY.

The balloons will NOT operate if the wind is present, so please plan accordingly. This time of year, it's likely that we will only have a few hours in the morning before the wind makes it unsafe to do the tethers.

BALLOON TETHER RIDES will be only sold onsite Friday, Saturday, and Sunday as long as wind and weather allow. Rides are \$25 per person. Event admission is additional and required.

Please note: Weight restrictions will apply to all aircraft flights and rides.

5K ON THE RUNWAY NIGHT RUN



The Upper Cumberland Air Fair 5K on the Runway Night Run is back for 2022. Friday, Oct. 14, at 6:30 p.m. is the starting gun, and it's a Runway 5K by the glow of runway lights - and stars, and the moon, hot air balloons, and whatever glowing gear you are wearing to frolic after dark in this super-cool fun run.

This is a timed 5K, with shirts and great finishers' medals for all runners and walkers. Awards will be presented to the first 10 people across the finish line, and everyone else will be there in good fun in a timed, but non-competitive, 3.1 mile run or walk on the coolest 5K venue in Tennessee.

Registration is \$50 per person, and each entry includes event admission, a T-shirt, runner's bib with number, and finisher's medal.

Air Fair admission is included in the run fee. Check-in for those participating in the race will begin at 4:30 p.m., Oct. 14. Admission is good for both Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, so you can run Friday night and come back to enjoy the fun for the weekend.
