Last year's starters all return to WCHS boys' basketball team

The White County High School Warriors are bringing back all of the starters from last season's team that made a championship run, and coach Eric Mitchell, who is in his 18th season as a coach, said he is hoping to build off that experience.

"We are returning all five starters and have six seniors who will all contribute," Mitchell said. "Each has a role to play, and as long as they play within our system and play for each other, we will be competitive."

Mitchell said he expects his team to be competitive in both the district and the region but knows it won't be an easy season by any means.

"We expect to be good enough to challenge in the substate," he stated. "We

play in one of the toughest districts and regions in the entire state, so our goals will be challenging yet attainable.

"Stone Memorial is loaded and returns most of a state tournament team. Upperman returns their best player. DeKalb returns their best player. Add to that tough non-conference rivals like Warren and Cookeville, and we have few, if any, easy outs," Mitchell said. "Injury wise, we have a few kids nursing some nagging injuries and will definitely not be 100 percent by the first game."

In addition to injuries sidelining a few members of the team, the Warriors are facing the challenge of preparing for the first tip-off of the season, while other members of their team are not available to practice with them.

"Our biggest weakness is not having a full team until football is over," Mitchell

said. "We are proud of the football team and support them as they continue a fantastic season, but it is tough when half of your team and starting lineup miss the first couple of weeks of practice. Especially when district play starts so early this year."

Mitchell said he hopes to see leaders start to emerge and set the tone for the team as they head into the beginning weeks of the season. He said he expects the leadership will be provided by the collective seniors and foresees sophomore Tripp Pinion emerging as a leader as well.

"They are a fantastic group of young men that the county can be proud to support," Mitchell said about the Warrior basketball team as a whole. "They are all good kids and work hard, and we hope the county will come out and support them as they have worked hard to be able to give

our community a team they can be proud to cheer on."

The Warrior head coach went on to say that he will be depending on his coaching staff - Tyler Hillis, Montuka Murray, and Cole Vaughn - to help direct the players and help them with skills practice, building team chemistry, and strengthening their mental focus.

"Realistically we have a chance to be a state tournament team," Mitchell said. "We should have been last year as we beat multiple state tournament teams during the season. We have a goal of defending our district title and making it out of the region to the sub-state," Mitchell said as he referenced the Warriors 21-9 record from last season. "We have the talent, but the health of players and how well they come together as a team and not individuals will determine how far we go."

WCHS girls basketball team ready for new season

As Michael Dodgen opens his eighth year as coach of the White County High School Warriorettes, he has some lofty goals for his team but says they are the same goals he sets every year.

“The goal for this team is a goal that every team has every year and that’s to compete and win a state championship,” Dodgen, who in his 22nd year of coaching said. “Our goals stay the same every year. We want to win a district championship, region championship, and play in the sectional game, which gives you the opportunity to go to MTSU and play for a state title. This team is a team with experience at many positions, but we have some young kids that we will need to gain some valuable experience.”

Dodgen said the team will be led by the seniors, and their guidance and leadership

need to be top notch every day.

“We have some young players that will be stepping on the floor for us this season that will have to lean on the older players every day for guidance,” Dodgen said. “We have five girls who started games for us last year that are coming back. Nia Powers and Celeste Reed started every game for us last season, while KK McDonald, KB Frazier, Lexie Golden and Karley Gentry all started various games throughout the year for us. These girls bring a lot of playing time experience to the floor and will be counted on to help lead us throughout the season this year. Ava Jones is another player who played valuable minutes for us last year and needs to continue to improve and get better every day.”

Last season, the Warriorettes finished strong, with a 23-8 record, but the veteran coach knows there is room to improve.

“We have to become a better defensive team in the half-court and handle the basketball better and limit our turnovers in the open floor,” Dodgen said.

Winning takes a team effort and, according to Dodgen, which extends to the coaching staff as well. He is quick to give credit to his assistants and acknowledges the impact they have on the White County girls’ basketball team.

“Shanee Wallace, Dylan Burton, and Hannah Leftwich - this group of assistants bring a lot to the table with our basketball team,” he said. “They help the girls on and off the floor every day and have a lot of pride and respect for the Warriorettes’ basketball program.”

Dodgen knows becoming a championship basketball team won’t be a walk in the park and expects his girls to be consistently challenged. He understands they will have to rise to new heights over and over throughout the upcoming season.

s team will be challenged every night not only in non-district games but in our league games also - our non-district schedule is very tough from day one,” he explained. “Meigs County, Tullahoma, and Sevier County will all challenge us in the Hall of Games the first week of the season. We also play Cookeville, Warren County, Van Buren County, and Shelbyville twice this year, and all of those games will be challenges.”

“Our district is hands down the best district in girls’ basketball in the state, no matter the classification,” Dodgen said. “We have great coaches and teams in our league, and every night will be a challenge for our team to show up and produce each night. Unlike some teams and schools around the state, we will not be able to sleepwalk through our league and win the tournament. The best basketball in the state is played in the Upper Cumberland, and this year will be no exception.”





